

## Volunteer Service Policy

Adopted by Volunteerism Committee October 2008

ABR Certification is required for volunteer service. Oral examining requires five years since initial certification.

### Service Awards: The system

#### Award levels:

"ABR Volunteer Service Award" - 24 cumulative points (certificate, lapel pin)

"ABR Distinguished Service Award" - 48 cumulative points (certificate, lapel pin, clock)

"ABR Lifetime Service Award" - 72 points (certificate, lapel pin, and crystal award).

#### Point system:

Oral examiner June - 5 points DR, 4 points RO, 3 points RP

Oral examiner (DR) November - 2 points

Year of MOC committee or exam-of-future committee participation (attended at least one in-person meeting & fulfilled writing commitment) - 4 points plus 1 point for Chair

Test Assembly meeting attendee - 2 points

Angoff panel participant - 1 point

SAM reviewer - per year with at least 2 SAMs reviewed - 1 point

Item writer - per year in which commitment was fulfilled - 2 points plus 1 point for Chair

"ABR Volunteer Service Award" - 24 cumulative points (certificate, lapel pin)

"ABR Distinguished Service Award" - 48 cumulative points (certificate, lapel pin, clock)

"ABR Lifetime Service Award" - 72 points (certificate, lapel pin, and crystal award).

Points are loosely based and awarded as one point per day of effort expended.
