RESIDENCY COMPLETION POLICY

Approved Board of Governors: February 9, 2024

Policy:

Effective July 1, 2026, it is the policy of the ABR that for residents in Diagnostic Radiology, Interventional Radiology, or Radiation Oncology to achieve board eligibility status, their residency must have been completed within the following time frames.

Procedure

Diagnostic Radiology residents must have completed their four-year residency within eight years from the start of the residency program.

Interventional Radiology residents in an integrated program must have completed their five-year residency within 10 years from the start of the residency program.

Interventional Radiology residents in an independent program must have completed their two-year residency within four years from the start of the residency program.

Radiation Oncology residents must have completed their four-year residency within eight years from the start of the residency program.

This policy is subject to change and modifications at any time. All changes must be approved by the ABR Board of Governors.
