

Initial Certification Medical Physics Part 1 Qualifying Exam: Re-entry Eligibility

APPROVED: Board of Governors Meeting – February 2023

Policy:

Medical Physics candidates who fail to pass the Part 1 qualifying exam within five years of their registration will have their applications canceled.

Procedure:

Candidates will be required to reapply for the Part 1 qualifying exam under the requirements in place at the time of application. Upon approval of the new application, the candidate will receive an additional five years of eligibility for the Part 1 qualifying exam, provided at least one Part 1 exam is taken each year.

Admission to board eligibility will be in accordance with current policy. Successful completion of a CAMPEP-accredited residency will be required.

This policy is subject to change and modifications at any time. All changes must be approved by the ABR Board of Governors.
